

REMEMBER!



The older I get the faster the years go by. I understand now more than ever what Solomon meant when he admonished, “Remember now your Creator in the days of your youth ...” (Ecclesiastes 12:1). He was communicating the fact that very soon you get older and physically (and often mentally) you are not the same. He employs several metaphors in v.1-8 indicating that life speeds by and very soon man returns to the dust from which he was created. The image that he presents that I like the most is in v.3 – “When the grinders cease because they are few, and those that look through the windows grow dim.” He was speaking about our teeth and eyesight beginning to fail as age marches onward.

So, **REMEMBER** God! As a matter of fact, do more than just remember. Solomon shouts, “Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is man’s all. For God will bring every work into judgment, including every secret thing, whether good or evil” (Ecclesiastes 12:13-14). From your youth reverence God and follow His will! Why? One day (Perhaps today) life ends, and the only thing that will matter at that moment is your relationship with Him.

Now, here we are in 2014 – a brand new year! Opportunities to honor God abound both on the individual level and the congregational. The question is, “What will you do with 2014?” I’m with Solomon – Let’s **REMEMBER** our Creator and His son Jesus. Why? “For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him” (2 Corinthians 5:21). Because of His love, God did what He did not have to do – GRACE! So, **REMEMBER!** (1 John 4:19)

I think it would be a great idea to use Psalm 118:24 as an every day guide in 2014 and beyond (Lord willing). It says, “This is the day the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.” Make every day a day to **REMEMBER!**
