## Are You Ready for That Hour?

**“Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation” (John 5:28-29).**

According to Jesus, in the first century, some were surprised to learn that a time was coming when everyone who had died would come out of the grave and face their Creator in Judgment. Many then, as many do now, believed that once you died that was it – everything was over. The truth is all people, from Adam until the last person ever born, will be held accountable for the manner in which they live their lives. 2 Corinthians 5:10 states: “For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.”

Matthew 25:31-46 provides a stimulating view of the moment of judgment. Jesus makes it perfectly clear that those who follow God's plan – His will, His teachings – will, in the end, find a glorious conclusion. He also makes it abundantly clear that the opposite will be true for those who disobey Him. Matthew 7:21 states: “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.”

If we are clothed with the blood of Jesus (Compare Galatians 3:27, Ephesians 1:7, Acts 2:38, 22:16 and Colossians 3:1-4), which also means continuing every day in a faithful walk/life (See 1 John 1:5-7), judgment will have a positive conclusion. Are you so clothed? Are you continuing your faithful walk? Are you ready for that hour?

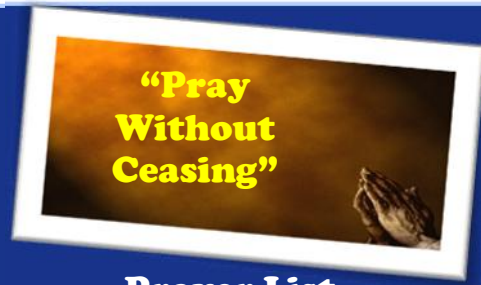
## Chris' Corner...

### Acts 6:1-7

**1**In those days when the number of disciples was increasing, the Hellenistic Jews among them complained against the Hebraic Jews because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food. **2** So the Twelve gathered all the disciples together and said, "It would not be right for us to neglect the ministry of the word of God in order to wait on tables. **3** Brothers and sisters, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them **4** and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the word." **5** This proposal pleased the whole group. They chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit; also Philip, Procorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas from Antioch, a convert to Judaism. **6** They presented these men to the apostles, who prayed and laid their hands on them. **7** So the word of God spread. The number of disciples in Jerusalem increased rapidly, and a large number of priests became obedient to the faith.

Each person has a vital part to play in the church and the kingdom. When called to help and do your part, what will you do? When the seven were chosen, they took on the responsibilities needed so the apostles could focus on other prayer and ministry of the word. We could see the result of this in v. 7 – the word of God spread. No matter what our parts are in the church and kingdom, if we all do them with our best, good things will happen, and God will be glorified!

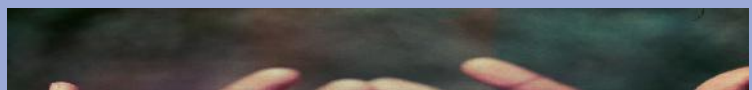
