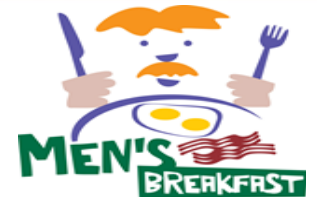

January 22nd is the deadline for L2L registration.

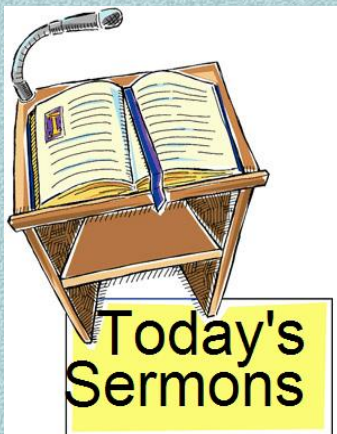

Matthew 5:13-16

13 “You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet. **14** “You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. **15** Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. **16** In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

There are many reasons why we lose our saltiness and dim our light as Christians. Perhaps it is fear that causes us to not speak up when we should and we just go along with the crowd. Maybe our pride blinds us to the needs of others. Sin has a way of preventing us from doing what we are called to do as followers of Christ. We cannot allow this to happen. Instead, we should be bold when sharing the gospel to others and consider others and what they are lacking. Our thoughts, words, and actions should reflect those of Jesus so that we can stick out in a positive way in this world.

What's the point of putting salt on food if you can't taste it? What's the point of a light if you cover it up? Likewise, what's the point of being called a Christian if we are not Christ-like? Jesus is telling us to do our job, as his disciples, so others will know him and God will be glorified.

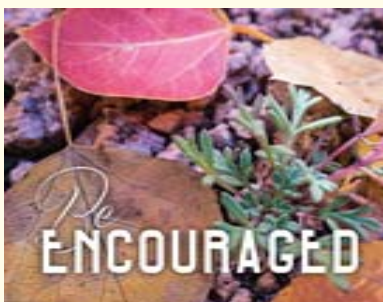
