10 In Damascus there was a disciple named Ananias. The Lord called to him in a vision, "Ananias!" "Yes, Lord," he answered.

11 The Lord told him, "Go to the house of Judas on Straight Street and ask for a man from Tarsus named Saul, for he is praying. **12** In a vision he has seen a man named Ananias come and place his hands on him to restore his sight."

13 "Lord," Ananias answered, "I have heard many reports about this man and all the harm he has done to your holy people in Jerusalem. **14** And he has come here with authority from the chief priests to arrest all who call on your name."

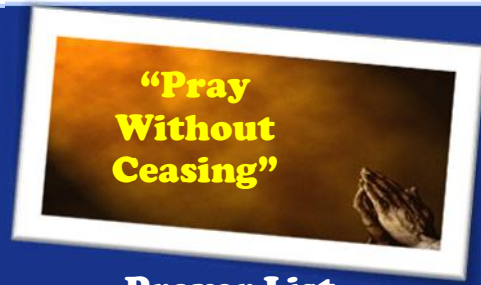
15 But the Lord said to Ananias, "Go! This man is my chosen instrument to proclaim my name to the Gentiles and their kings and to the people of Israel. **16** I will show him how much he must suffer for my name."

When Ananias first heard what God wanted him to do, he naturally hesitated. At that time Saul had gained a reputation for persecuting those who followed Christ, and going to him was a tough task for Ananias. Later on in the chapter Ananias does end up listening to God and goes to Saul. As a result, Ananias ends up helping converting Saul and eventually would baptize him. Saul would change his name to Paul and would go on to write much of the New Testament.

We often do the same thing and have some initial hesitation when we first see what God wants us to do on His behalf. That's ok as long as we also listen to God and go through with His will. Sometimes the things we are called to do are scary, but with God anything is possible.

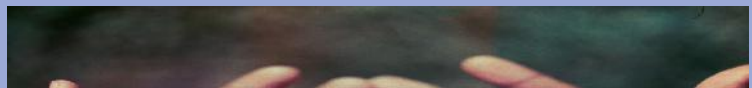
