Reading Our Bibles

As a student at the Preston Road School of Preaching, I participated in school assigned campaigns for Christ. Two times a year students were strongly encouraged to contribute to these gospel efforts. We would knock doors, set up Bible studies, conduct those studies and prepare the local folks for the follow-up process after the campaign was over. In addition, one of our professors would travel with us and conduct a Gospel Meeting at night while we knocked doors and such during the day. It was fun, informative, rewarding and exhausting.

In 1981 I was knocking doors in a middle-class community. I was paired with another student (For safety and support reasons we always went out in pairs). We knocked on this one door and a sweet elderly lady answered. It took her a while to get to the door and we soon found out why. This lady was completely blind.

As we announced ourselves and the reason for our stopping by, she became increasingly excited. She thanked us over and over again for caring enough to be out in the community sharing the Good News about Jesus. She invited us in by saying, “Please come in. I have something very valuable to me to show you.” She led us to a table in the center of her living room. There, in front of us, was a Braille Bible. This lady began telling us how much reading her Bible meant to her. She once again said, “This is the most valuable thing I own.” My heart melted!

How do you feel about the word of God? Does 2 Timothy 2:15 resonate with you? Can you relate to the writer of Psalm 119? Do you “Hunger and Thirst for Righteousness?” (Matthew 5:6). My prayer is that all of us might feast upon God’s Word daily. It is our spiritual food!

Ducks

Ducks are pretty amazing creatures. Let me share 5 duck facts with you and some valuable lessons.

1 - As each Duck flaps its wings it creates uplift for the birds that follow. By flying in a V formation, the whole flock adds 71 per cent greater flying range than if each bird flew alone.

LESSON - People...Christians who share a common direction travel on the thrust of one another.

2 - The ducks flying in the rear of the formation honk to encourage those up front to keep up their speed.

LESSON - We need to make sure our honking is encouraging and not discouraging.

3 - When a duck gets sick or wounded, at least two ducks drop out of formation and follow it down to help and protect it. They stay with it until it dies or is able to fly again.

LESSON - We must stand by each other in difficult times as well as when we are strong.

4 - When the lead duck tires, it rotates back into the formation and another duck flies to the point position.

LESSON - It pays to take turns doing all the tasks.

5 - When a duck falls out of formation, it suddenly feels the drag and resistance of flying alone.

LESSON - We should try and stay in formation with those headed where we want to go...Heaven!

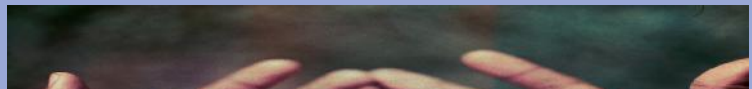
