## You Are Our Everything

“Then one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him, ‘Which is the first commandment of all?’ Jesus answered him, ‘The first of all the commandments is: ‘Hear, O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is one. And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.’ This is the first commandment. And the second, like it, is this: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater than these” (Mark 12:28-31).

February 14<sup>th</sup> on the American calendar is called, “Valentine’s Day.” Many people exchange cards, candy, gifts or flowers with their special “Valentine.” It is a day to celebrate love and romance. The intention - beyond the commercialization - is to help folks focus on the importance of their significant other.

The first day of the week - according to the Bible - is called the Lord’s Day (See Acts 20:7 and Matthew 28:1). On this day, Christians assemble together (See Hebrews 10:25) to celebrate the love of God that has been demonstrated in the person of Jesus (See Romans 5:8). Through our collective worship (“Bowing Down”) we say, “Father, we love you with all of our hearts, souls, minds and with all our strength. We love you every day of our lives because ‘You first loved us’” (See 1John 4:19). In this way we are saying to our God and our Savior, “You are our everything, you are our all!”

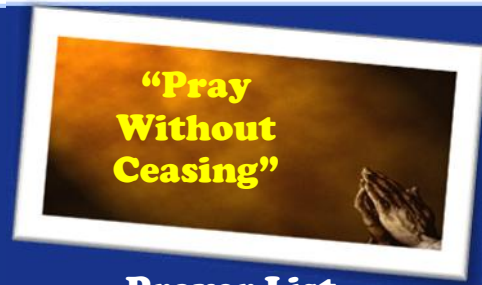
The act of dying for our sins was a beautiful act of love from Jesus to us. Living for others is a great way for us to show love to God and His people. This week, serve others and share God's love.

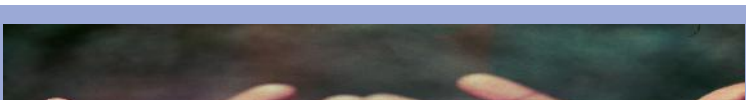
