Procrastination

One lady wrote: “My sister was bemoaning the fact that she had procrastinated cleaning and organizing her house. She felt a lot of pressure to get moving. That afternoon she phoned, sounding glum. ‘I went to the bookstore and I bought a book on how to get organized. I was all fired up, and decided to clean out all the shelves in the living room. While I was working, I found the same book. I had bought it a couple of years ago.’ ”

Procrastinate – a verb meaning “To delay or postpone action; to put off doing something.”

Hara Estroff Marano in Psychology Today wrote, “There are many ways to avoid success in life, but the most sure-fire just might be procrastination. Procrastinators sabotage themselves. They put obstacles in their own path. They actually choose paths that hurt their performance.” Sounds a whole lot like Acts 24:25. “ Now as he [Paul] reasoned about righteousness, self-control, and the judgment to come, Felix was afraid and answered, “Go away for now, **when I have a convenient time** I will call for you.”

The list of things about which we might procrastinate is endless. So, **how can we avoid becoming a procrastinator?** First, develop a better concept of the brevity of life (See James 4:13-14). Second, understand that not doing what is right and necessary is at the very least unhealthy and at the worst it is sin (See James 4:17). And third, postponing, for whatever reason, doesn’t help you. It only prolongs any agony, and/or it potentially robs you of success. And in truth, delay doesn’t honor God (See Ephesians 3:21).

Listen to the inspired man Paul, “Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation” (2 Corinthians 6:2). May we use today to claim God’s offer of salvation. And may we continue every day claiming the same and honoring Him in all things! Take care.

With more than 300,000 websites pertaining to pornography, one can see that we have a growing problem. The Internet is the cheapest, fastest way to get pornography out into an open market. Before the Internet, pornography was found in magazines behind the store counters, on movie channels, and was found in movies. Take a look at your favorite television show and see how many times a sexual situation comes up. The "sexual revolution" as some call it has taken off with the Internet. For example, try typing in www.whitehouse.com and see what pops up... definitely not the White House. Students working on a history paper in school recently went to this site and found pornography instead of history. What a surprise for the students.

Unfortunately, due to the First Amendment, pornography websites are allowed on the Internet. There are types of filtering programs that can be purchased or downloaded which stop pornographic material from reaching your computer or smart phone. Monitoring all sites a person goes on and whom that person speaks to on the Internet is another way to prevent it.

Eric Tooley of Noble Choices, leads a Biblical consideration of pornography. He equips you to remain Godly in today's culture. Stories, interaction, humor, games, and multi-media keep you engaged and make it memorable. Eric requires a parent program before the student program. The program is designed to teach parents how to protect their children from pornography. Several of our Elders have heard Eric's presentation and feel that it is one that should be made available to anyone in our congregation that wants to learn more about combating this growing problem.

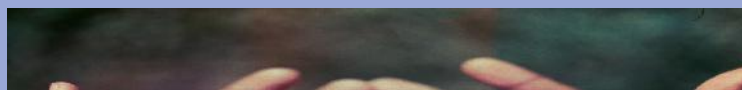
