



“As the Father has sent Me, I also send you”

John 20:21

These words were spoken by Jesus following His resurrection and before His ascension. They were spoken to His disciples and through extension to all of us. They are comparable to Matthew 28:18-20, Mark 16:15-16 and Luke 24:46-47 which have been called *The Great Commission*. Essentially, Jesus intends for His followers to take the “Good News” to every person that they possibly can reach.

In Acts 8:4 we read, “Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere preaching the word.” Christians in the first century understood that taking the Gospel to the world was their responsibility. More than a responsibility, they seemed to feel that it was a special privilege. And more than simply being a privilege, they obviously looked at as being the natural thing for any Christian to do. Luke confirms this way of thinking by recording Peter and John saying, “For we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard” (Acts 4:20). It was the normal course of life!

Brothers and sisters, we have received the best news of all – You can live forever through Jesus! We know that all people sin and fall short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23). We understand that sin has the penalty of death attached to it – that is total, final separation from God (Romans 6:23). We also recognize that God sent Jesus into the world to be the atoning sacrifice (1 John 2:2), to shed His blood so that we who apply that blood (See Romans 6:4, Acts 2:38, Ephesians 1:7) might be forgiven and be reconciled to the Father (See Romans 5:1-11). And we additionally know that when someone joins with Jesus and remains in harmony with Him all during their life, heaven awaits (See 1 John 1:7-10 and John 14:1-3). It's *Good News!*

Christians are still being sent by Jesus to proclaim this news. You are being sent! I am being sent! We (The church collectively) are being sent! Our mission is to introduce Jesus to as many people as we possibly can! I pray that you are taking this assignment seriously. I pray that we (the church) will always make this our top priority. We have a great opportunity to collectively reach out next Sunday as we give to our Mission program. May we all do our part! Take Care!
