Sound Doctrine

“But as for you, speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine... (Titus 2:1).

In Titus chapter one, Paul said that he left Titus in Crete that he might, “Set in order the things that are lacking, and appoint elders ...” (1:5). The apostle then spells out the criteria that Titus was to use in appointing elders (1:6-9). The reason elders and faithful preachers (as well as faithful members) are needed is strongly stated in 1:10-16. In his day, as well as ours, there were “Teachers” that were “insubordinate, both idle talkers and deceivers ... whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole households, teaching things which they ought not ...” (1:10-11). He further states: “They [deceivers] profess to know God, but in works they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work” (1:16). Consequently, Titus, as an evangelist, is told to “Speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine.”

“Doctrine” means “Teaching.” “Sound” equals “Healthy” or “Unblemished.” It is obvious that the church and the world in Paul’s day, as in ours, had people who presented unhealthy doctrine. That unhealthy teaching is summarized in 1:14 – “giving heed to Jewish fables and commandments of men who turn from the truth.”

Brothers and sisters, the “Truth” has been revealed (See 2 Peter 1:19-21). The scriptures are “able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus” (2 Timothy 3:15). For, “All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work” (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

Let me ask you a pointed question. Does your life “Speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine?” Think it over! Take care!

Or again, "I will be his Father, and he will be my Son"? **6** And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him." **7** In speaking of the angels he says, "He makes his angels spirits, and his servants flames of fire." **8** But about the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever; a scepter of justice will be the scepter of your kingdom." **9** You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy." **10** He also says, "In the beginning, Lord, you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands." **11** They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. **12** You will roll them up like a robe; like a garment they will be changed. But you remain the same, and your years will never end." **13** To which of the angels did God ever say, "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet"?

Jesus was special. He was with God from the beginning. He was greater than any angel, man, or any other creature created. He was perfect and did not sin. He even sits at the right hand of the creator of the universe. That's why the fact that Jesus was sent to die for us shows how much God loves us. 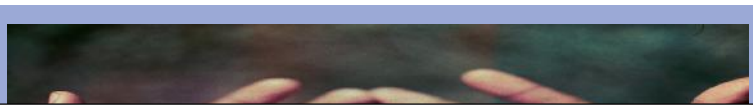
