We long for that day! We live today for that day!!!

But what do we do in the meantime? The apostle Paul tells us in Titus 2:11-14. ¹¹For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, ¹²teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, ¹³looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, ¹⁴who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.” He also says, “You were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light” (Ephesians 5:8).
