What Do We Do?

I recall an old joke that I heard a few years ago: "From a cruise ship, passengers could see a bearded man in tattered clothes on a small island. The man was shouting and desperately waving his hands. 'Who is it?' a passenger asked the captain. 'I have no idea. Every year when we pass by, he goes crazy.' "Obviously, the man was crying out to be rescued.

Likewise, people are in desperate need of saving today. The sad thing is that a good many folks don't even realize it. Because God and eternity are not in the thinking of most people (See Romans 1:28), their spiritual welfare is of little concern to them. They fail to realize that all people sin (Romans 3:23), sin separates us from God (Isaiah 59:1-2, Romans 6:23) and that Jesus came, died and was resurrected to deal with our sin problem (See 2 Corinthians 5:21). And when we take advantage of God's Grace through Jesus (See Titus 2:11-14), we no longer face eternal death, but instead have the promise of eternal life (See Galatians 3:26-29).

The question for those of us who are saved by the blood of Jesus is this. "What do we do when we pass by those who need saving – whether they are waving or not – whether they realize it or not?" May every one of us STOP being oblivious to the LOST who are all around us! May we open our eyes and see that the "Fields are white unto harvest" (John 4:35). "Go into all the world and preach the gospel ..." (Mark 16:15-16).

For it is written, "'You shall worship the Lord your God and him only shall you serve." 11 Then the devil left him, and behold, angels came and were ministering to him.

Jesus didn't take what Satan was offering. In return, Jesus was attended to buy angels. You might say he passed up on devil's food cake and received angel food cake instead. When we don't give into temptation and trust in God we too will be rewarded on earth and after with a Heavenly treat.
