## Mission Sunday

“And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned” (Mark 16:15-16).

“Mission Sunday” is a bit of a misnomer. Some might believe on the surface that we (the West Broward church of Christ) focus upon “Missions” just one time a year. Of course this is not true. We give attention to our “Mission” of “Go into all the world ...” (Mark 16:15-16), all the time. Everything we do as a church is designed to save souls and to keep the saved ones saved (See Ephesians 3:1-11). When we have a Youth Rally or a Marriage Conference or a Summer Series or a Congregational Fellowship or Bible Class, etc., we are doing so to open doors and strengthen lives; resulting eventually in heaven.

“Mission Sunday,” though, is an important day regarding our overall mission as the church of Christ. We are told to “Go Preach.” This command directs us to our neighbors both locally and abroad. Sharing the “Good News” about Jesus should be our number one priority. And wherever He is not known (Across the street or across the ocean), we are to “Go.” Literally the command is, “As you are going along.” The great commission is a daily, person-to-person and nation-to-nation process.

“Mission Sunday” provides you and me with the opportunity to take part in spreading the news in places outside of our daily reach. Our elders have selected “Works” in other places where souls are being touched. We send money, prayers and workers to those places. Consequently, people – souls – are obeying the Gospel – God is being honored and glorified!

I pray that you have come prepared today to participate in taking the Gospel to the world – as I continue to pray that we might take the Gospel to our neighbors across the street. Please give or pledge as the “Mission Sunday” contribution is taken. Take care.

## Chris' Corner...

Acts 13:42-52

**45** When the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy. They began to contradict what Paul was saying and heaped abuse on him.

**46** Then Paul and Barnabas answered them boldly: "We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of eternal life, we now turn to the Gentiles. **47** For this is what the Lord has commanded us:

"I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth."

**48** When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and honored the word of the Lord; and all who were appointed for eternal life believed.

**49** The word of the Lord spread through the whole region. **50** But the Jewish leaders incited the God-fearing women of high standing and the leading men of the city. They stirred up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region. **51** So they shook the dust off their feet as a warning to them and went to Iconium. **52** And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.

At the end of this account some Jewish leaders were upset and stirred up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, so much that they were forced to leave and go into another city. Oddly enough Paul and Barnabas were filled with joy. How could this be? It was possible because they had the Holy Spirit and took joy in knowing they were doing what God wanted them to, which was spreading the Word of God. Outside events didn't affect them, they had joy from within. We as Christians should find joy in knowing that we too are doing the right thing, and have hope in Jesus.

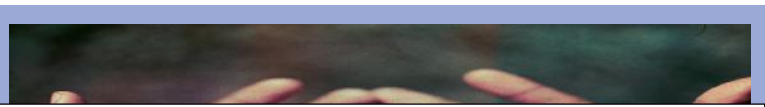
