## God is with Us?

A Sunday School teacher challenged her children to take some time on Sunday afternoon to write a letter to God. They were to bring their letter back the following Sunday. One little boy wrote, "Dear God, we had a good time at church today. Wish you could have been there."

The truth is, God is with us when we assemble. Moreover, His Holy Spirit is with us every day, all the time (See Acts 2:38). He "Dwells" in us (Romans 8:11). His presence makes a difference in who we are and what we do (see Romans 12:1-2). The apostle Paul put it this way: "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me" (Galatians 2:20).

God is with us as we worship! God is with us as we daily attempt to live for Him! (See Hebrews 13:5). When we assemble (and for the Christian that is every Sunday, not just some Sundays), we find strength in praising Him, studying about Him, praying to Him and remembering Him through the Lord's Supper. The association we share and the friendships we make provide a foundation of support that sustains us in good and bad times. It is no wonder the Hebrew writer stressed the important of consistent, faithful attendance (See Hebrews 10:24-25).

## Chris' Corner...



### Romans 6

5 For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. 6 We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. 7 For one who has died has been set free from sin. 8 Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. 9 We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. 10 For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. 11 So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. 12 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. 13 Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. 14 For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.

God doesn't do anything randomly, and there are many reasons why baptism requires full submersion in water. When we go under and rise up again we are uniting in Christ's death and resurrection. The submersion symbolizes Jesus' death and burial, and we arise from the waters as Jesus arose from the grave. We are called to be like Christ in every way, and in baptism we lay our old selves to rest and begin anew free from sin.
