## I Just Want To Be Where You Are

Don Moen composed a song in 1987 with the above title. Verse one says, “I just want to be where You are, dwelling daily in Your presence. I don’t want to worship from afar, draw me near to where You are.” Verse two continues, “I just want to be where You are, in Your dwelling place forever. Take me to the place where You are, I just want to be with You.” Then there’s the Chorus: “I want to be where You are, dwelling in Your presence. Feasting at Your table, surrounded by Your glory. In Your presence, that’s where I always want to be. I just want to be, I just want to be with You.”

This is one of my all-time favorite songs. It’s simple, yet profound. It’s comforting as well as challenging. It’s one of those songs that cuts to the heart of genuine Christian desire. Ephesians 5:19 affirms that singing is, “Speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord.” The words of this song definitely “Speak” to me. They resonate in a very, very special way!

While singing it, I’m reminded of Jesus’ words to His disciples as their hearts were saddened. He had just announced that He was going away (Crucifixion, resurrection and ascension). He said, “Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father’s house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also” (John 14:1-3).

All the disciples could do was think about being in His presence (Literally, then spiritually and ultimately in the future). It motivated them. It comforted them. It kept them moving forward and looking upward no matter what life’s circumstances were. Are you living daily

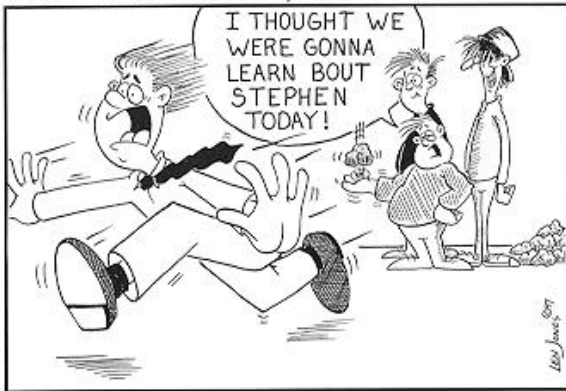
