## Let It Go!

Let all bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice. And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you” (Ephesians 4:30-31). Easy? No! Necessary? Yes!

## Chris' Corner...

### 1 Corinthians 10:31- 1 Corinthians 11:1

31 So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. 32 Give no offense to Jews or to Greeks or to the church of God, 33 just as I try to please everyone in everything I do, not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved. 1 Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ.

Our theme for this year's ACTION youth rally is "Reflect." This idea comes from what Paul says in 1 Corinthians 11:1, where he is saying to be like him as he is like Jesus. This concept brings up a lot of questions. Who are we imitating or following? Are they Christ-like? If they aren't walking in the footsteps of Jesus, we should not follow their lead. Instead we should look to those who are setting a heavenly example and be more like them.

What about us? When people see us what, or who, do they see? Do they see just another person of this world, or do they see Jesus? What do our actions reflect? To answer these questions we must first do some inner reflection. Only then can we reflect God's light to a dark world.

Consider this analogy- we are like the moon. We are imperfect and produce no light, but still can brighten up the world with the light of the Son. Like the moon, we sometimes get between the world and the source of light, causing more darkness. The choice is ours; will we get in the way and block out God from the world, or will we shine for Him? Now is the time to take ACTION and reflect Jesus to the world!
