Jochebed

“Pharaoh commanded all his people, saying, ‘Every son who is born you shall cast into the river, and every daughter you shall save alive’ ” (Exodus 1:22). “And a man of the house of Levi went and took as wife a daughter of Levi [See Exodus 6:20]. So the woman conceived and bore a son. And when she saw that he was a beautiful child, she hid him three months. But when she could no longer hide him, she took an ark of bulrushes for him, daubed it with asphalt and pitch, put the child in it, and laid it in the reeds by the river’s bank. And his sister stood afar off, to know what would be done to him” (Exodus 2:1-4). And all of us know the rest of the story. Moses was saved from the river by Pharaoh’s daughter and eventually led the Israelites from captivity in Egypt (Read Hebrews 11:23-29).

“Jochebed, the mother of Moses, is one of the underappreciated mothers in the Bible, yet she also showed tremendous faith in God” (Christianity.about.com). Her story echoes the lives of so many mothers throughout history unto this present time. These are women who deeply care for their children; even placing themselves at great risk to make certain that their children survive and prosper. Matthew 25:33-40

33 And he will place the sheep on his right, but the goats on the left. 34 Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. 35 For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, 36 I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.' 37 Then the righteous will answer him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? 38 And when did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? 39 And when did we see you sick or in prison and visit you?' 40 And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.'

As we can see from this parable, God is always watching us. Also, our actions, and lack of actions are being taken into account. We are told by Jesus to love our neighbors as ourselves. Sometimes this can be difficult because we either don't see the results of our love, or we are flat out rejected when we love others. Maintaining Good Health Seminar

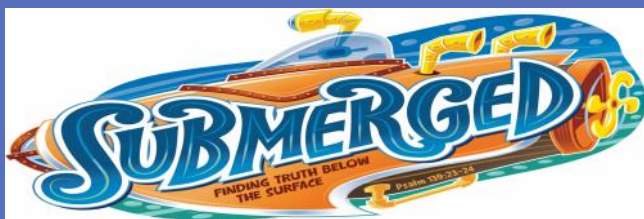

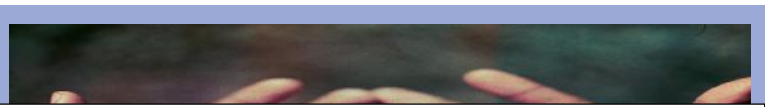
