Red Sea Rules Continued

Michael Hursey’s April 26th sermon was on “Red Sea Rule #8.” God, through Moses, gave the Israelites 10 rules to observe in following his commands and overcoming the enemy. Exodus 14 provides us these rules we can use for Christian living today. Here are two more:

Red Sea Rule #3

Acknowledge your enemy, but keep your eyes on the Lord.

Exodus 14:5-9 (NKJV)

⁵ Now it was told the king of Egypt that the people had fled, and the heart of Pharaoh and his servants was turned against the people; and they said, "Why have we done this, that we have let Israel go from serving us?" ⁶ So he made ready his chariot and took his people with him.

⁷ Also, he took six hundred choice chariots, and all the chariots of Egypt with captains over every one of them. ⁸ And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh King of Egypt, and he pursued the children of Israel; and the children of Israel went out with boldness. ⁹ So the Egyptians pursued them, all the horses *and* chariots of Pharaoh, his horsemen and his army, and overtook them camping by the sea beside Pi Hahiroth, before Baal Zephon.

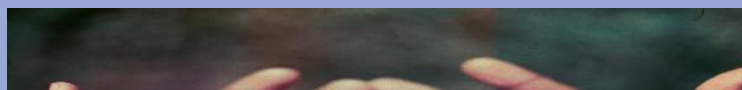
