Last Week's Question:

What was the show bread? How was it used in service? List Scriptures as references.

Answer:

Show bread, shew bread, bread of the Presence, continual bread, or literally "bread of the face," was unleavened bread placed upon a table in the sanctuary of the temple along with the seven-branched candlestick and the altar of incense. Every Sabbath, twelve newly-baked loaves representing the twelve tribes of Israel were put into two piles, six in each, surmounted by a censer of incense, where they remained until the following Sabbath. They were then replaced by twelve new loaves and must be completely eaten by the priests before the priests could leave the Holy Place, according to Leviticus 24:5-9. The bread of Presence is also mentioned in Exodus 25:30, Exodus 39:36 and Exodus 40:23. David and his men ate this bread, even though it was unlawful for them to do so, as found in 1 Samuel 21:1-6. Jesus even referred to this act in Matthew 12:3-6.

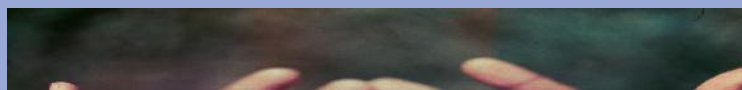
