Chris' Corner...

James 4:7-8

7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. 8 Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

1 Peter 5:6-10

6 Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, 7 casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you. 8 Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. 9 Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. 10 And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.

The concept sounds simple. Satan has bad intentions for us, and if we resist him and his temptations he will flee from us. God has good intentions for us, and if we draw near to Him and His ways He will take care of us. The concept is simple and ideal, but our execution sometimes makes it more complex.

The concept is easy to grasp but hard sometimes to believe. We understand that the devil will flee if we resist him, but do we believe it? God lays plans for us in His word, and for the most part we know what we should do but we must also carry them out. If we do this our faith will show, and through that God will be glorified.
