Answer:

I received an answer from Abraham Inetianbor that I found to be well thought out and wanted to include it with the answer. Here it is:

On the same note, according to Psalm 51, David who also broke the TEN, prayed for sincere repentance. Though all TEN were broken in a short span of time, there is no evidence to show it was all in one day.

1. **Serve no other gods**-David allowed his lust to be "god" to which he bowed.
2. **The Name of God**-David took the Holy Name of God in vain when he proclaimed to be a man of God but this act was everything but.
3. **Graven images**-Unlike Aaron with the Israelite molding a physical structure, David engraved the image of Bathsheba as she bathed so deeply that he forgot the God he loved so much for this sinful stretch.
4. **Remember the Sabbath**-This or any other day being kept holy for God was out the window once he allowed lust to rule.
5. **Honor thy father and mother**-Allowing a glimpse of his parents teaching to sink in at this particular time may have prevented him from sinking into such a wicked and premeditated sin.
6. **Not kill**-David sent the murder request to Joab, so it was his desire that Uriah be killed.
7. **Not commit adultery**-that was the clearest of all David's law breaking.
8. **Not steal**-He stole the wife of his neighbor and friend Uriah as Nathan clearly pointed out in the story of the lamb.
9. **Not lie**-His false response and deceptive cover up was a lie when the messenger came with the sad news of Uriah's death.
10. **Not covet**-David broke this law as he so coveted his neighbor's wife that he would steal her and kill her husband.
