Memorial Day!

Memorial Day is observed on the last Monday of May. It dates to 1864 when women placed flowers on the graves of their dead following the battle of Gettysburg. The next year the same thing was done in Vicksburg, Mississippi. From those initial commemorations, known then as *Decoration Day*, came the current holiday (Becoming a federal holiday in 1971). The idea is to remember and honor those individuals who have given their lives in service/defense of our country. The desire is to actively engage in keeping their memories and actions alive by speaking about and honoring their sacrifices!

For Christians, there is a weekly Memorial Day. It is the greatest of all memorials. On the Lord's Day, we collectively and individually remember Jesus' death, burial and resurrection through the Lord's Supper. Jesus took the penalty of sin for all mankind upon Himself, even though he committed no sin (See 1 Peter 2:22). He died for you! He died for me! He took your place and my place. Because of sin we deserved death (See Romans 6:23). However, through His blood (Applied in baptism – Acts 2:38 and Ephesians 1:7) we are forgiven! By His sacrifice, we are saved (See Romans 3:21-26)! So, every Sunday (See Acts 20:7) we lovingly and faithfully remember Jesus (See 1 Corinthians 11:23-29). And every day, because of what He did, we live for Him (See Romans 12:1-2).

Matthew 6:25-34

25 "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? **26** Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? **27** And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? **28** And why are you anxious about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, **29** yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. **30** But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? **31** Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' **32** For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. **33** But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. **34** "Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.

Reading this scripture should bring us relief and peace. Knowing that God cares about us more than anything also brings joy to our lives. Hopefully this will motivate us to live for Him and bring glory to His kingdom. So don't worry, be happy, and praise The Lord for loving us.
