Memorial Day

Tomorrow is Memorial Day in America. Every year Americans pause to remember the men and women who have died while serving our country in the armed forces. The time was originally called “Decoration Day” because following the Civil War, the Grand Army of the Republic, a Union veterans group, decided to decorate the graves of the War dead. Memorial Day should not be confused with Veterans Day. Memorial Day honors the dead while Veterans Day rightly honors all military veterans, living and dead. It is my prayer that **Memorial Day** will always mean much more to us than just another day off from work or the symbolic beginning of summer.

For the Christian, every Lord’s Day (Sunday) is **Memorial Day** (See Acts 20:7). We, as the followers of Christ, pause to collectively “Remember” Jesus as He directed (See Luke 22:14-23). This connection took place when we were baptized into Christ for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38), resulting in our current and continual “Walk in newness of life” (See Romans 6:1-23). 2 Timothy 2:24-26

24 And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, 25 correcting his opponents with gentleness. God may perhaps grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth, 26 and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, after being captured by him to do his will.

The great commission was Jesus giving us our final orders before He ascended to Heaven. We are to make disciples, baptize, and teach all that He has commanded. In 2 Timothy we get a look into how we are to do this. How we say something is just as important, if not more, as what we say. When we are teaching, preaching, rebuking, or correcting, being gentle in our approach is key. Stating the truth on a matter is not an excuse to be harsh in the delivery. Instead, we are to be gentle.

1 Corinthians 16:14 says we are to do everything in love. This can be difficult sometimes when we are in the middle of a discussion or trying to prove a point. We can lose sight of the big picture and turn people away from the truth if we don't have love. Remember to listen to people's questions and treat them with respect, while avoiding foolish debates. If we do this, those who oppose us will be more likely to hear what we have to say and turn towards the truth. We are to be strong and bold when we are preaching the Gospel, but follow Jesus' examples of gentleness. We can win an argument, but at the same time lose a soul.

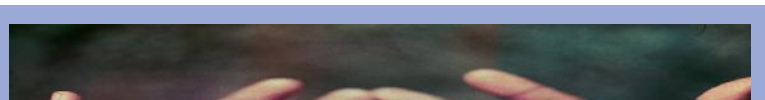
