Genesis 15:1-6

1 After these things the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision: "Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great." 2 But Abram said, "O Lord God, what will you give me, for I continue childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?" 3 And Abram said, "Behold, you have given me no offspring, and a member of my household will be my heir." 4 And behold, the word of the Lord came to him: "This man shall not be your heir; your very own son shall be your heir." 5 And he brought him outside and said, "Look toward heaven, and number the stars, if you are able to number them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be." 6 And he believed the Lord, and he counted it to him as righteousness.

God promised Abram many things, and in verse 6 we see that Abram believed God. He didn't just believe "in" God, but believed what God said. It's one thing to believe "in" God and that He exists. It's another thing to actually believe Him. Believing God and what He says and promises should motivate how we live.

Believing God means that you accept the truth of what God has done, is doing, and will do. Therefore when the Bible says God created everything and sent Christ to die for our sins, we take God at His word. When the scriptures state that baptism is necessary for salvation we stress that importance to others. And when Jesus claims he will return and there will be a day of judgment we should repent and live for God. So thank God for all He has done and trust in what He will do.
