What Is Your Approach?

Before leaving the house this morning, I finished off a package of Oreo's, a pot of coffee, the rest of the cheesecake, some saltines and a box of chocolates. Dr. Phil was right ... you have no idea how great I feel right now!”

I'm fairly certain that that was not what Dr. Phil had in mind. But these days it seems that a great many people only want instruction that doesn't alter their current direction or cause them any extra effort or discomfort. The saddest thing of all is that some are more willing to listen to the “Advice” of fallible men (i.e. Dr. Phil, etc.) than to God (Infallible) as revealed in His inerrant Word. The psalmist had the absolute best approach: “Oh, how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day. You, through Your commandments, make me wiser than my enemies; For they are ever with me” (Psalm 119:97-98).

What approach do you utilize for your life? Do you direct your own way? Do you buy in to man's way? Or, do you listen to God? Remember, “All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work” (2 Timothy 3:16-17).
