Can anyone hide himself in secret places, so I shall not see him?" says the Lord; "Do I not fill heaven and earth?" says the Lord.

7 Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from your presence? **8** If I ascend into heaven, you are there; if I make my bed in hell, behold, you are there. **9** If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, **10** even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me.

God is omnipresent, which means He is all places at all times. This might be a hard concept to grasp or comprehend. We might sometimes wish we could be at multiple places at once, but God actually can! This can mean bad news for some and at the same time great news for believers.

The "bad" news about God being everywhere at all times is that if someone is living in sin, He knows. Typically if someone is in sin they don't want anyone to find out. Embarrassment and guilt can motivate people to hide their sin even more. If we are honest with ourselves and realize we can't hide from God, then that can motivate us to stop living in sin.

The great news about God being omnipresent is that He hears all our prayers and can take care and love us all at the same time. We don't have to wonder if He knows our problems because He absolutely does. More importantly God cares about all of our problems too. God is right here (and there) waiting for you to turn to His loving arms.

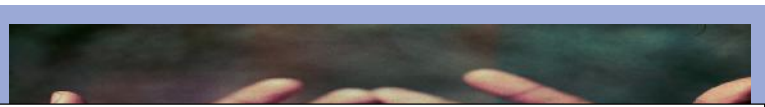
