“And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord” (Ephesians 6:4).

First, Happy Father’s Day!

Fathers are extraordinarily important in the raising of children. There is no way you can conclude anything else from the above verse. The impact that they make can be either positive or negative. Even when they are indifferent regarding their responsibility, they make a lasting impression.

So, how do Fathers (Mothers and mentors too) make a lifelong Godly mark on their children? For answers we turn to the context of Ephesians 6:4.

1. Consider who you are and what you’ve learned in Christ (Ephesians 4:17-24). Jesus has cleansed you and shown you a better way!
2. Allow your actions to be an imitation of your Father in heaven (Ephesians 4:25 – 5:2). He has shown you a better way! See 1 Corinthians 13:13.
3. Be a light to the world (Ephesians 5:3-14). Dispel darkness, evil. Your children will see. This is the better way!
4. Display wisdom in everything you do (Ephesians 5:15-21). Wisdom/knowledge comes from God and His word. This is the best way!
5. Be a Godly spouse and child – one that models marriage as God designed (Ephesians 5:22 – 6:3). Marriage and family as God intends is the best way!

Applying all of this to your life will certainly make a difference in “Bringing up your children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.” Again, Happy Father’s Day!

## Chris' Corner...

Luke 10:38-42: "As Jesus and his disciples were on their way, he came to a village where a woman named Martha opened her home to him. She had a sister called Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet listening to what he said. But Martha was distracted by all the preparations that had to be made. She came to him and asked, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself? Tell her to help me!" "Martha, Martha," the Lord answered, "you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed—or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her."

Sometimes we make the same mistake as Martha. We get caught up on things that aren't necessarily bad, like technology, work, or even family, but we get distracted and miss out on what is going on around us. Even worse, we sometimes miss out on God, even when He is right in front of us.

When we want to give someone our full attention, eye contact is important. How do we give God our full attention and eye contact? We can pray, close our eyes and look to Him. We can read His word and see what He is saying to us, fellowship with His people, and stop to look at His creations all around us. These are just some ways I encourage you to give God your full attention and good eye contact.
