## Aaron's Angle...

### What Makes God Happy?

When the prodigal son returned to the father in the latter portion of Luke 15, the son could not bring himself to see the joy on his father's face. In fact, assuming his father did not outright reject him, the son assumed that he would be made like one of the servants. You could imagine the disbelief and the likely shame of the son when he is hugged, kissed, has a ring put on his finger, and a party thrown on his behalf! When I put myself in the shoes of this son, I imagine having great difficulty accepting the father's kindness toward me. I would think, "Perhaps he just took me back because of pity?" or "I don't really belong here, and my father must have a lot of tolerance to accept me back." Nothing could be further from the truth. The father was joyful beyond belief simply because his son had come home.

As Christians, perhaps we slip into that prodigal son mind-set. Perhaps we fail to see how happy God is simply because we are His children and have come home. Paul writes, "I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints" (Ephesians 5:18). Notice, we are the glory of God's inheritance! God glories in you and me! Too often I beat myself for being a sinner while seldom ever rejoicing that I have been saved. The Christian life is one of joy, not of guilt. And joy is not only on our side of the equation, but also much more joyful on God's side. So then, what makes God happy? You.
