Freedom

“Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage” (Galatians 5:1).

On July 2, 1776, the Second Continental Congress voted to approve a resolution of independence declaring that the thirteen American Colonies would be free from Great Britain's rule. Following that vote, Congress turned to the Declaration of Independence, which was approved on July 4th. A day earlier John Adams wrote to his wife: “The second day of July, 1776, will be the most memorable epoch in the history of America. I am apt to believe that it will be celebrated by succeeding generations as the great anniversary festival. It ought to be commemorated as the day of deliverance, by solemn acts of devotion to God Almighty. It ought to be solemnized with pomp and parade, with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires, and illuminations, from one end of this continent to the other, from this time forward forever more” (Letter from John Adams to Abigail Adams, 3 July 1776, Adams Family Papers. Massachusetts Historical Society. Retrieved June 28, 2009). He missed it by two days!

While the celebration of July 4th is warranted, another time in history stands out as the truest time of deliverance. The day Jesus died at Calvary stands as the day the price was paid for our eternal deliverance from sin (See Acts 20:28, 1 Corinthians 6:19-20, Ephesians 1:7 and 1 John 2:1-2). The day Jesus was resurrected, He was declared to be the Son of God with Power (Romans 1:4) giving us our ETERNAL HOPE (See Romans 5:1-11). And when you and I are connected through baptism to His death, burial and resurrection, we are truly set free! (See Romans 6:1-7). PRAISE BE TO GOD!

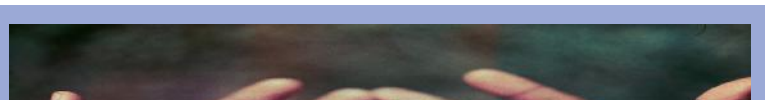
