Seeing As God Sees!

This past Sunday morning I spoke to you about the Heart. The scripture reference that was emphasized was 1 Samuel 16:7. Samuel was urged to not base his selection of a new king on the outward appearance of Jesse’s sons. Instead, Samuel was reminded that God’s view and man’s view are two different things. “For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.”

There was one thing that I wanted to stress that due to time I was unable to. As I related my recent heart attack and bypass surgery to the spiritual heart problems that often exist today, I wanted to highlight the vision change that has taken place. My eyesight has dramatically improved. So much so that I have had to return to the optometrist and have my prescription updated. The doctor told me that because my glucose levels are different and more stable, my eyesight is better. It is amazing all the good things that happen to you in a physical way when you get you heart right!

Now, think about the spiritual heart - the core of man. Consider the implication. When your heart is right with God, and you are thinking as He thinks, then Proverbs 23:7 takes over - “For as a man thinks in his heart, so is he.” Your vision, so to speak, improves! You are able to “See Him who is invisible” (See Hebrews 11:27 and 2 Corinthians 4:16-5:1). Consequently, you are able to count your blessings. You are able to rejoice in God’s forgiveness. You are able to celebrate because of hope. You are able to love your enemies and pray for them. Etc. This doesn’t mean that your problems disappear. They are still there. But because you see as God sees, you are able to navigate the minefield of life until you eventually arrive at heaven’s gate and hear these words, “Well done good and faithful servant. Enter in” (Matthew 25:21).

So, how’s your vision? How’s your heart?

1 John 2:15-17 "Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the father is not in him. For everything in the world – the cravings of sinful man, the lust of the of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does – comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever."

Satan mainly tempts us in three different ways: with what feels good, looks good, and our pride. He did it with Eve, Jesus, and still with us today. In Genesis 3:4-6, Satan uses those three things to tempt Eve into eating from the tree. He told her she would be like God, knowing good and evil. Eve then saw that the fruit was good for food and was pleasing to the eye. She gave into the temptation and ate of the tree. Sin entered the world, and Eve and Adam's relationship with God changed.

Satan tempted Jesus in the same three ways. Read Luke 4:1-13. In verse 3, he focuses on the fact that Jesus hasn't eaten in forty days and tells him to turn stones into bread. In verse 5 he shows Jesus all the kingdoms of the world and offers them to Jesus. In verses 9-11 he toys with Jesus' pride by questioning if he truly is the Son of God. Jesus didn't give in to Satan's temptations.

Satan's tactics haven't changed. He attacks our senses and our pride. When we are tempted by Satan today, let's be like Jesus and choose God over the world and ourselves. By doing this, we will live with Him forever.
