

Mentoring!

Webster's Dictionary defines *Mentor* as "Someone who teaches or gives help and advice to a less experienced and often younger person." The word originated in Greek mythology; *Mentor* was a friend of Odysseus entrusted with the education of Odysseus' son Telemachus. He was Telemachus' trusted counselor and guide. Synonyms include *teacher, guide, counselor, tutor, coach* or *adviser*. Essentially a Mentor is someone who cares about someone else and seeks to help him or her develop into a well-rounded, successful person.

The Bible is filled with information about older people guiding and helping younger ones. Paul told Titus, "But as for you, speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine: that the older men be sober, reverent, temperate, sound in faith, in love, in patience; the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things — that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed. Likewise, exhort the young men to be sober-minded, in all things showing yourself to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility, sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you (Titus 2:1-8). It is obvious that everyone should be an example to others, helping them along life's way, especially the older toward the younger. Even older kids assisting younger kids! 1Timothy 4:12 says, "Be an example . . ."

Now in order for any mentoring effort to be successful there must be willing participants. The older, or more skilled, must have the desire to pass on their experience and knowledge through a caring relationship. This requires time, energy, thought and dedication. The younger, or less skilled, must recognize their need to acquire more knowledge and experience, and then commit to the leadership of a mentoring partner.

It is my prayer that both older and younger will recognize and embrace the value of a mentoring relationship. In this way we ensure Godly Spirits and Actions for generations to come! Take care!
