Aaron's Angle...

Not Everything in the Bible Is True

Don't get me wrong, God inspired every word of the Bible. But sometimes the Bible quotes unbelievers or other people who were misinformed about who God is or about what man is like.

Eliphaz said "What is man, that he could be pure? And he who is born of a woman, that he could be righteous? If God puts no trust in His saints, and the heavens are not pure in His sight, How much less man, who is abominable and filthy, Who drinks iniquity like water!" (Job 12:14-16). But God said "Have you considered My servant Job, that there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, one who fears God and shuns evil?" (2:3). Who said that God puts no trust in His saints? God certainly seemed to put trust in Job! Who said that man drinks iniquity like water? God said that Job was blameless and that he shunned evil.

It is important that we have an accurate view of ourselves, because it will eventually inform our behavior. Have we been caught by the assumption that humans are somehow incurably weak, and that we can't help but sin? Do we sometimes think, "I'm only human"? It is true, I'm a human. But that is hardly a negative! In fact, Jesus Himself was human like you and me. For "Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same. . .in all things He had to be made like His brethren. . ." but notice that "He is not ashamed to call them brethren" (Hebrews 2:11, 14, 17). Jesus stands beside you and He has no shame in what you are. Don't buy into Satan's negative lies. Take God's view of yourself and live a life of service and joy.
