“Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night” (Psalm 1:1-2).

It confirms that what we are doing is right and worth it. We can take joy in knowing that if we do God's works and will, then He will take care of us. 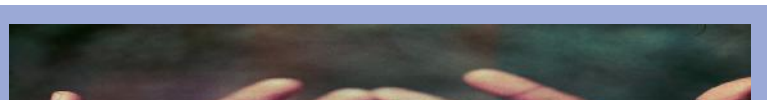
