Aaron's Angle...

How to Get a Crown (or Bone Rot)

Full disclosure, I'm not married. I don't have the experiences or insights that a married man has. But what I do have is the insight of Scripture. "An excellent wife is the crown of her husband, But she who shames him is like rottenness in his bones" (Proverbs 12:4).

What difference exists between the two men in these hypotheticals? Absolutely nothing. The only difference is in his wife. The man with an "excellent" wife has her as a crown. This is something that makes the husband proud, something that people's eyes are drawn to in admiration. Conversely, the man with a shameful wife has rottenness in the bones. Hidden, harmful, debilitating.

Unmarried men: You and I are in the same boat. We have the opportunity to pursue an "excellent" woman to marry. Paramount among other traits that we should be looking for is strong Christian character. Think about the woman you would like to marry. If she thinks and acts like Christ, what more could you ask? If she does *not* think and act like Christ, then this is a deficit in her character and will likely cause problems in the future.

Unmarried women: You should be looking for a man who emulates Christ, just as a man should look for the same in you. Nevertheless, Proverbs says that your husband is only half of the equation. You could marry the best guy in the world, but if you are a shameful woman he will likely be a man with rottenness in his bones. If you are excellent, he will wear you like a crown.

If you want to be married, what are you doing right now to prepare yourself? Are you becoming Christ-like? Give it some thought, then demonstrate some action!
