GOD WANTS TO TALK TO YOU

Smart phones are a great communication tool for work today. Something I've noticed is that we are attentive awaiting the arrival of a message. When notification sounds or a small light appears we look to see who wrote and what they want. Sometimes when we have no messages, we check the phone with the concern of whether someone has written. This practice has become a habit that psychologists call "syndrome sensation of a message."

In the Bible the story of a young man named Samuel who served the Lord under Eli the priest is told. One night Samuel heard a voice calling his name, and thought it was Eli, when he came, he answered that he had not called him, go lie down again; but the same situation happened a second and a third time. Eli then realized that God was calling Samuel and explained how he should respond. So when the Lord called him for the fourth time, "**Samuel said: Speak, for your servant is listening**" (1 Sam 3:10).

What a wonderful story! ... The Lord calling his servant.

How would life be if we were all more aware of God's voice message on our phone? Samuel's attitude to be alert to the voice of God can become a basic pattern for your life. I ask you: Are you now hearing the voice of God speak? Are you more aware of the vibration of a mobile phone than the soft and gentle voice of the Lord that comes to us through His Word and His Spirit?

I pray that the Holy Spirit help us, as Samuel, to learn to listen and discern the voice of the Lord and to answer: "Speak to me Lord, I'm listening to you."

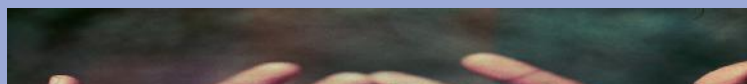
