Are You Jesus’ Person?

“I had never known such a man as he and never shall again,” said journalist William Allen White after meeting President Theodore Roosevelt in 1897 for the first time. “He overcame me. And in the hour or two we spent that day at lunch, he poured into my heart such vision, such ideals, such hopes, such a new attitude toward life and patriotism and the meaning of things, as I had never dreamed men had. After that, I was his man.”

I think all of us have at some point in our lives encountered a person that just won us over. For me that person was J. Woodrow Davidson. Woody, as we called him, was the preacher for the Lawndale church of Christ in Houston, Texas in 1982 when I moved there as youth minister. Many of my approaches to ministry were adopted from him. When Woody suddenly passed away in the fall of 1984, it was almost like one of my parents had died. He was a special man who loved the Lord and the Lord’s people, and he inspired others to do the same.

Woody was the type of man that would draw you in and then point you to Jesus. His mission in life was to help others to know the Savior. As White said about Roosevelt above (“I was his man”), Woody wanted everybody to be “Jesus’ man.” He emphasized to me more times than I can remember about what it means to “Belong to Christ” (See Galatians 3:26-29). He would always say what John the Baptist said concerning Jesus; “He must increase and I must decrease” (John 3:30). I am so very grateful that Woody was Jesus’ man and that he led me and so many others to be Jesus’ man too.

How about you? Are you Jesus’ person? Take care!

Matthew 26:69-75 Now Peter was sitting out in the court yard, and a servant girl came to him. "You also were with Jesus of Galilee," she said. But he denied it before them all. "I don't know what you're talking about," he said. Then he went out to the gateway, where another servant girl saw him and said to the people there, "This fellow was with Jesus of Nazareth." He denied it again, with an oath: "I don't know the man!" After a little while, those standing there went up to Peter and said, "Surely you are one of them; your accent gives you away." Then he began to call down curses, and he swore to them, "I don't know the man!" Immediately a rooster crowed. Then Peter remembered the word Jesus had spoken: "Before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times." And he went outside and wept bitterly.

When we as Christians read this account of Peter it's easy to think, "How could he?" especially when we are sitting in our pews on a Sunday morning. We like to think that we would not give in to the pressure if we were in Peter's sandals. One thing we have to remember is that Peter was one of Jesus' closest friends and followers and even he turned his back on Jesus. If Peter can give in and deny Christ, then we certainly can face temptation to do the same.

One thing that can help us avoid turning our back on Jesus is to know what will happen when he returns. **Matthew 10:32-33** reminds us that what we do to others will eventually happen to us. In this case the consequences will last for eternity. Thankfully Peter realized his mistake and turned back to Christ, something we might need to do also.

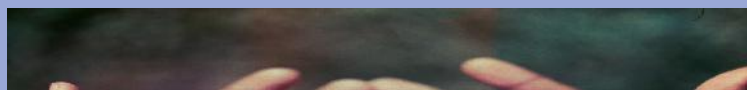
