A new seminary student had just finished preaching his first sermon, and he was convinced that everyone was as impressed with his efforts as he was. In the car on the way home he asked his wife, “How many great preachers do you think there are in the world today?” She smiled lovingly, put her hand tenderly on his shoulder and said, “One fewer than you think, dear.”

Have you ever had to be humbled? My dad used to refer to it as “Being taken down a peg.” Often times we do allow our egos to swell. We even can become obnoxiously arrogant. The apostle Paul recognized this tendency. He said, “For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith” (Romans 12:3). This statement was in reference to 1st century Christians thinking their spiritual gift (or ability) was superior to the gift(s) of others. He essentially says that our thinking should be a bit more clearer (“Sober”) and unpretentious.

Peter said, “Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for ‘God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble’” (1 Peter 5:5). The world, and more specifically our individual lives, would be so much better with love and humility behind the steering wheel.

3 Getting into one of the boats, which was Simon's, he asked him to put out a little from the land. And he sat down and taught the people from the boat. 4 And when he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch." 5 And Simon answered, "Master, we toiled all night and took nothing! But at your word I will let down the nets." 6 And when they had done this, they enclosed a large number of fish, and their nets were breaking. 7 They signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. 8 But when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord." 9 For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish that they had taken, 10 and so also were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." 11 And when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed him.

Throughout the Bible we see God use unlikely people to do His will. Here we see Jesus calling fishermen to join him to be disciples and ultimately calling others to God. These men weren't the wealthiest or in positions of power, but were still used to establish and further the kingdom. This applies to us today. Whatever your job or role in life is, you can glorify God and bring others to Him.
