Chris' Corner.....

Acts 27:21-25

21 Since they had been without food for a long time, Paul stood up among them and said, "Men, you should have listened to me and not have set sail from Crete and incurred this injury and loss. **22** Yet now I urge you to take heart, for there will be no loss of life among you, but only of the ship. **23** For this very night there stood before me an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I worship, **24** and he said, 'Do not be afraid, Paul; you must stand before Caesar. And behold, God has granted you all those who sail with you.' **25** So take heart, men, for I have faith in God that it will be exactly as I have been told.

Earlier in Acts, Paul was visited by Jesus and told he was to preach in Rome. Through God's providential ways, Paul found himself a prisoner on a ship to Rome. Later while on the ship Paul was visited by another angel reminding him that he would make it to Rome and preach before Caesar. Therefore in the middle of a terrible storm, Paul was confident and calm because he knew he was safe and that God would deliver him from his current situation.

Joshua 1:9 reminds us to be like Paul in the storm. We are to be strong and courageous because God is with us and will take care of us. When things go wrong it is easy to "jump ship" and try to take things into our own hands; when in reality letting go, having faith, and trusting God are our best actions. If we stick close to God and his plan, He has promised that He will get us to our Heavenly destination.

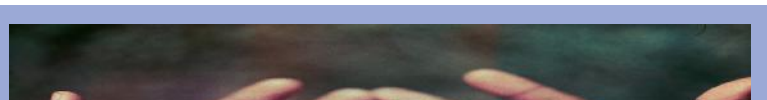
