The Inspiration of the Bible - Part 3

Today we continue presenting evidence from the pages of the Bible that speak to its claim of inspiration (See 2 Timothy 3:16-17). Once the Bible is established as "Credible" (Inspired), then we possess a standard by which we can measure everything – theologically and in life. It is only when we grasp that the Bible is the very Word of God do we have a basis for agreement – religiously or otherwise.

I mentioned last time that the prophetic accuracy of the Bible is evidence for the Bible actually coming from God. Only an omniscient (All-knowing) Supreme Being (Our Creator) could have revealed to men what would accurately come to pass in 50 or 100 or 500 years (Again examine 2 Peter 1:20-21). It is resounding that historically documented events foretold in the Bible actually came to pass.

Around 700 B.C., the prophet Micah foretold that the coming Messiah would be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2). This came to pass according to Luke 2:1-20 in A.D. 30. The record of Jesus' life was also captured by historians (Josephus and Tacitus) and withstands the denial of many. Only the Omniscient Creator could have known!

Isaiah, in the 8th Century B.C., said that the Messiah would enter the world by miraculous birth (Isaiah 7:14). He declared that a "Virgin" would give birth to the Son of God, the Savior of the world. Many have insisted that the Hebrew word used here simply means a "Young woman." However, when you compare this verse to its fulfilling counterpart some 750 years later (Matthew 1:23), there is NO DOUBT that the Holy Spirit intended "Virgin" in Isaiah 7:14. The Greek term used in Matthew 1:23 refers to a woman that has never had sexual relations. This is inspired commentary for Isaiah 7:14. Only the Omniscient Creator could have known!

There are hundreds of prophecies in the pages of the Bible. Many of them, if not all of them, have logical or historical or archaeological documentation of their fulfillment. The Bible is indeed the very Words of God! More evidence next week! Take care.

Jesus Appears to Thomas

Now Thomas (also known as Didymus), one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

At first when reading this account it would be very easy to look down on Thomas and be surprised why he didn't believe Jesus was raised. To Thomas, seeing was believing. Sadly this is the way the world thinks and we sometimes fall into the same trap. But as we know in 2 Corinthians 5:7, we live by faith and not by sight.

When Thomas felt the scars he then truly believed two things. 1) Jesus, who many witnessed die horribly on a cross, was actually alive and in front of him. 2) Since he was indeed alive and overcame death, Jesus was the Son of God.

When we claim to believe we must believe the same two things. As Jesus told Thomas, if we believe without even seeing him, then we will be blessed.


