External/Internal Evidence

As we continue our thoughts about the Bible’s inspiration, we move to two new areas – Science and Archaeology.

I have always said, “True science and the Bible will always agree because both have the same author – God.” According to the Bible, God created the universe, earth and everything in them (See Genesis 1-2, Psalm 19:1-6, Psalm 33:6-9, etc.). There are scientific statements/facts in the Bible that prove its inspiration.

1. Ecclesiastes 1:7 refers to the “Hydrologic Cycle” – Rain, water to the sea, evaporation, weather systems, rain and so forth. How did Solomon know to write this down so accurately in roughly 950 B.C.? The Creator told Him!

2. Genesis 17:12 instructed the Hebrews to circumcise their infant sons on the 8th day of life? Why the 8th day? According to researchers, Vitamin K is a key ingredient in blood clotting. Too much or too little can result in excess hemorrhaging. A little boy’s body begins to release Vitamin K on the 5th day. The perfect amount was present on the 8th day. Only the Creator would have known this all-important medical fact!!!

3. Leviticus 17:11-14. Moses stated, “Life is in the blood.” We didn’t fully understand this medically until the early 19th century A.D. Before that many thought destructive vapors were in the blood – thus leading to the sometimes fatal practice of “Bloodletting.” How did Moses know to write this down? God revealed it to him (See 2 Peter 1:20-21).

4. Psalm 8:8 declares: “... and the fish of the sea that pass through the paths of the seas.” Matthew Fontaine Murray, who lived from 1806 to 1873, has been called, “The father of modern oceanography.” His nickname was “Pathfinder of the seas.” His conviction concerning the Bible coming from the Creator caused him to believe the truth of Psalm 8:8. He set out to discover those “Currents” or “Paths” (Gulf Stream, etc.). All because the Bible said so!!!

Matthew 13: 1-9 The Parable of The Four Soils

1 That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the lake. 2 Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat in it, while all the people stood on the shore. 3 Then he told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. 4 As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. 5 Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. 6 But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. 7 Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. 8 Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. 9 Whoever has ears, let them hear."

In **Matthew 13:18-23**, Jesus explains this parable. He reveals that there are four types of soil, or four types of people that receive the word.

- The first soil represents someone that doesn't understand the message. Either they aren't mature enough or they just don't want to understand.
- The second represents someone who hears and receives the word for only a short time, because there is no root.
- The third represents someone who hears and receives the word for perhaps a longer time. Later the world and its influences change them and they become unfruitful.
- The fourth is someone who heard and understands the word. They have deep roots and produce good fruits for the Lord.

When you hear the message about the kingdom, which soil are you?
