



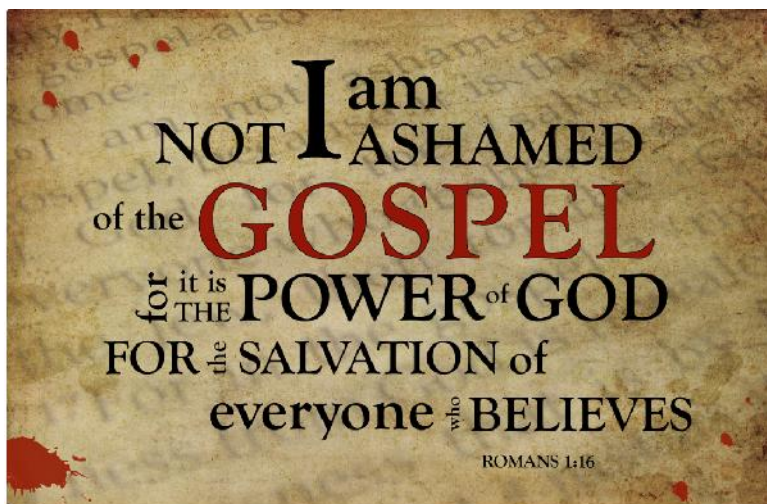

Terry's Tidbits

The Gospel is the “Good News” about Jesus. He (The Son of God) left heaven, came to earth, lived perfectly as a man and became the atoning sacrifice for mankind (Death, Burial and Resurrection – See 1 Corinthians 15:1-8). God did what He did not have to do in sending Jesus to redeem us (See Ephesians 2:1-10). He took the penalty of sin upon Himself (See 2 Corinthians 5:21). He did it because He loves us (See John 3:16, Romans 5:8, Ephesians 5:2).

Consequently, when we enter into Jesus through the Death, Burial and Resurrection (Baptism – See Romans 6:4), we experience the undeserved forgiveness of sins (See Acts 2:38, 22:16). Essentially, we become Sons of God (See Galatians 3:26-29).

Furthermore, as long as we “Walk in Newness of Life” (Romans 6:4) and “Walk in the Light” (See 1 John 1:5-7), heaven is ours (See John 14:1-6).

It is no wonder then as to why the apostle Paul said that the Gospel is, “The Power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes.” Do you believe? Remember, Faith = Belief + Action!

Hebrews 3:7-11

7 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, "Today, if you hear his voice, 8 do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness, 9 where your fathers put me to the test and saw my works for forty years. 10 Therefore I was provoked with that generation, and said, 'They always go astray in their heart; they have not known my ways.' 11 As I swore in my wrath, 'They shall not enter my rest.'"

When God speaks to you either through His word, the Holy Spirit, or any other way how do you react? Especially when what He is saying is something you don't like to hear. Often when we don't understand or agree with God's words, we tend to harden our hearts and look for other words or opinions that line up with ours. As we see in these verses, when we react that way we are rebelling against God. We are supposed to follow God and His words no matter what they are because in the end God knows what is best. We may not understand or even like what we hear from God, but we need to have faith and trust He will take care of us. This can be difficult at times, but it is necessary. We can look at past examples of others whose hearts were hardened and things didn't work out for them.

When Moses was leading the Israelites to the Promised Land, they didn't listen to him and God's instructions. They didn't keep their faith and ended up wandering the desert for years. We can learn from their mistake and open up our hearts when we receive the word of God. If we do, God will take care of us.

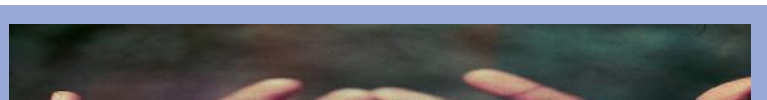
