



Time!

"See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil." ~ Ephesians 5:15-16

How much time do we waste in an average day? I suppose the concept of "Wasting" is relative. Your definition of "Time Management" and/or "Productivity" might be different than mine. You might consider an activity (or lack thereof) vital to your well-being. I might consider the same endeavor not of similar value. I'll bet, though, there are some things that we can agree upon.

1. **Time is a precious commodity.** Once you use it, you lose it. You can never get it back. The text speaks about "Redeeming the time." When you purchase something, you usually value it and take care of it. It must be the same with the gift of time. Yes, it is a gift from God!
2. **Time must be used wisely.** Prudent behavior and sensible Time Management are keys in succeeding in just about anything. As a parent you must devote quality time to your children. In education you must organize and discipline yourself to study. In business you will not succeed by misusing time and opportunity. Appropriating the proper use of time is essential! The text says we are "Foolish" if we fail to do so. Great things happen, though, when time is used to honor and glorify God!
3. **Time should be respected.** This is true regarding your personal time and that of others. The text states, "The days are evil." Essentially, the "Evil One" is a master manipulator. He will do whatever it takes to throw us off course. He can even use you to throw somebody else off course. In the arena of "Time," respect is a must. If you are habitually late for instance, several things are happening. 1). There is no respect/value assigned to the time God has given you. 2). There is very little, if any, respect/detail being applied to the task set before you. It is not important! And 3). There is absolutely NO respect/appreciation being offered for the people who have to adjust because of your tardiness. Think about this the next time you are tempted to be late for an appointment or even Bible class. Consider the message you are sending regarding the event and the other people involved.

Let's do our best to use this wonderful gift of time to honor God and build up other people. Think of the world this would create. It begins with me! It begins with you!
