What Does the Bible Say?-About Salvation

~ Part One

Since over the last five weeks we have established that the Bible is indeed from God and is perfectly accurate, we move on today to a discussion of some imperative biblical subjects. The first topic is “Salvation.”

The word “Saved” literally means “Rescued.” Mankind is in need of rescue because “All have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23). “Sin” means “Missing the mark” (Original Greek) or “Transgressing God’s law (1 John 3:4) or “Knowing [from the Bible] the right thing to do and NOT doing it” (James 4:17). The penalty for sin is death; all die physically (See Genesis 2:17) and spiritually (See Romans 5:12 and 6:23). However, by solving the spiritual or eternal component to the sin problem, man is rescued from both physical and spiritual death. Essentially, when a person dies physically they continue to live in the heavenly realm forever (See John 11:25-26). So, how does God make this happen?

God had a plan before the world began (knowing that men would disobey) to deliver man from the penalty of sin (See Ephesians 1:4 and 1 Peter 1:20). This plan involved His One and Only Son leaving heaven and coming to earth as a man (See Philippians 2:5-11). Here He (Jesus) would live a sinless, perfect life (See Hebrews 4:14-16 and 2 Corinthians 5:21) and offer himself (His life, His blood) for our (Mine and your) sins (See Hebrews 9:12-14 and Ephesians 1:7). Remember, sin demands death. The Blood of animals cannot permanently take away sin. But, the perfect, sinless blood of Jesus can (Read Hebrews 9 and 10). He reconciles man (who was split apart from God because of sin) to God by His precious blood (See Romans 5:1-11 and 1 John 1:5 – 2:2).

We are to rule over the fish in the sea, birds in the air, and the animals on the land. God even gave us access to all the plants on the earth. We are so special that we were even created in God's image. God thinks we are special, so much that He sent His son to die for us. Because of His love and how He values us, we must live our lives for God, in love and humility so that we may one day see Him in Heaven.
