Hebrews 2:6-8

6 It has been testified somewhere, "What is man, that you are mindful of him, or the son of man, that you care for him?"

7 You made him for a little while lower than the angels; you have crowned him with glory and honor, 8 putting everything in subjection under his feet." Now in putting everything in subjection to him, he left nothing outside his control. At present, we do not yet see everything in subjection to him.

Isaiah 14:12-13

12 "How you are fallen from heaven, O Day Star, son of Dawn! How you are cut down to the ground, you who laid the nations low! 13 You said in your heart, 'I will ascend to heaven; above the stars of God I will set my throne on high; I will sit on the mount of assembly in the far reaches of the north.'"

What a great contrast between Jesus and Satan. Jesus was with God from the beginning. He was willing to lower himself below the angels and become human. While on earth, he went around serving others and meeting their needs. He even went so far as to die a horrible death and go to the grave on our behalf. 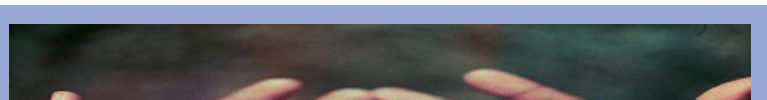
