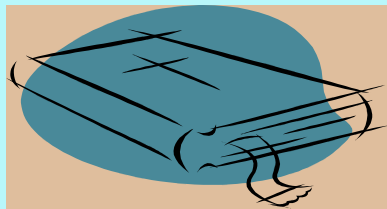


A Winning Attitude!
