## Prepare!

As I sit at my desk on Wednesday morning, my mind is racing concerning what I need to do to prepare for the potential strike by Hurricane Matthew. Items need to be moved inside the house. How about safeguarding and/or fortifying the church building? What about ministering in the aftermath? A lot of preparation is necessary!

Peter said that the Day of the Lord will come as a “Thief in the night” (2 Peter 3:10) - essentially unexpectedly - So be ready!

Have you prepared by entering into Jesus? (See Galatians 3:26-29; Romans 6:1-7). Are you continuing to prepare by “Walking in the Light” (1 John 1:5-7)? And regarding the storm (Literally and symbolically), Jesus will never abandon you (See Matthew 28:20; Hebrews 13:5).

### Matthew 10:40-42

**40** "Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives him who sent me. **41** The one who receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and the one who receives a righteous person because he is a righteous person will receive a righteous person's reward. **42** And whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly, I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward."

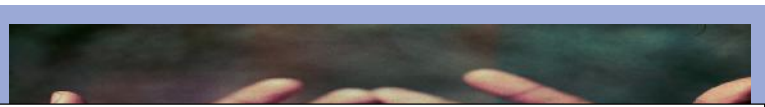
