

## The Worship Assembly



**“Let all things be done decently and in order” (1 Corinthians 14:40).**

The book of 1 Corinthians was written in part to correct some growing problems that existed in the Corinthian church. The apostle tackled many subjects that are equally troublesome today. One of the subjects was regarding worship and the misuse of spiritual gifts (Chapters 10-14).

A careful study of the mentioned section reveals that the brethren were making worship assemblies more about themselves instead of worship being about God. In Chapters 10 & 11 they were turning the Lord’s Supper into a common meal. In Chapter 12 they were debating about whose spiritual gift was the greatest or most meaningful. Paul had to explain to them that eventually miraculous spiritual gifts would cease and that “Faith, Hope and Love” would remain with Love being the greatest gift (Chapter 13). Then in Chapter 14 he corrects the misuse of the spiritual gift of tongues (Speaking in a language you had not previously studied or learned). He informs them that when no one understands what is being spoken, no edification occurs. What we say and do in worship should be designed to praise and exalt God while at the same time building up my brother in Christ.

Paul concludes his discussion about collective worship in 14:40. Everything we do is to be done decently and in order. The word “Decently” is from a Greek word indicating that we should not draw attention to ourselves (Loud outbursts, speaking out of turn, etc.). Anything that would draw attention away from God or prohibit edification of the group is not appropriate. The word “Order” indicates the idea of sequence. There must be proper arrangement and common respect if God is to be honored and His people edified.

Let us never forget that worship is about all of us collective saying to God, “We praise You for Who You are and What You have done and are doing for us.” Essentially, “Thank you for Jesus and our Hope.” Take care.

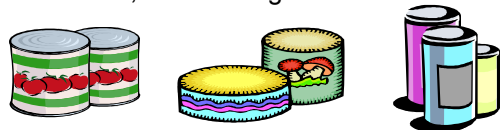
