What Does the Bible Say?-About Being Faithful to God

~ Part Three

Another aspect of living faithfully to God has to do with how we conduct ourselves every day.

One of the best chapters in the Bible (And there are many great ones) describing genuine faithfulness is Colossians three. The apostle begins with where our minds must be in vv:1-4. We should have our focus on “Things Above,” looking forward to the “Glory to be revealed.” He continues by saying that Christians are required to “Put to Death” the old ways of sin and, as “God’s Elect,” embrace our new way in Christ (vv:5-14). Paul does a great job describing the various aspects of “Old” and “New.” Then, through the Holy Spirit, he concludes with some general admonitions that, if embraced, will change the individual and help to change the entire world (vv:15-17).

Faithfulness to God is more than just attending church services. Attendance is crucial, but Godly living is paramount. When speaking about love, Jesus established an eternal principle in John 13:34-35. He said, “... by this all will know that you are my disciples” This is abundantly true about loving one another and it is equally true about other biblical imperatives. People will know that you “Belong to Christ” (See Galatians 3:26-29) by **HOW** you live your life!

Exodus 17:8-13 (NIV)

8 The Amalekites came and attacked the Israelites at Rephidim. 9 Moses said to Joshua, "Choose some of our men and go out to fight the Amalekites. Tomorrow I will stand on top of the hill with the staff of God in my hands." 10 So Joshua fought the Amalekites as Moses had ordered, and Moses, Aaron and Hur went to the top of the hill. 11 As long as Moses held up his hands, the Israelites were winning, but whenever he lowered his hands, the Amalekites were winning. 12 When Moses' hands grew tired, they took a stone and put it under him and he sat on it. Aaron and Hur held his hands up—one on one side, one on the other—so that his hands remained steady till sunset. 13 So Joshua overcame the Amalekite army with the sword.

Moses was given a difficult task to help win the battle, but he wasn't alone and had help. God sometimes calls on us to do His will and it seems too hard or even impossible. We often focus on how difficult the task is that we get discouraged and think we aren't able to accomplish it. But we must not forget God will also provide us with the tools to do His will. He has given us instructions in the Bible, fellow Christians that can encourage us, and the perfect example in Jesus. With God all things are possible if we trust in Him and use the gifts He has blessed us with.
