The pattern of the early church is clear from Acts 2:42-47.

"And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved."

This passage demonstrates that early Christians continued in sound doctrine and worship, and were active regarding one another resulting in growth. There is no doubt that God intends for His family, the church to grow. Growth comes by all of us being faithful to the gospel that He has revealed and by caring for one another.

Over the next few weeks I will use this space to communicate just how our C.A.R.E. Group program is going to work. Our main goal is simply to be the Church that is revealed in the Bible. We believe that if we do things God's way, then God will bless what we do. Take care.
