What Does the Bible Say?-About the Church-Part Two

The church (You and me) not only belongs to Christ (See Matthew 16:18) and should be identified as belonging to Him (cf. Romans 16:16), the church is also the “Body of Christ” (See Colossians 1:18 and Ephesians 1:22-23). And, there is only “One Body” (See Ephesians 4:4-6).

There are several passages that address the unique description of the church as Christ’s Body (cf. Romans 12:4-8). The one that I want to emphasize is 1 Corinthians 12:12-27. Please read and reread and reread this section, and then reread it again. He states “Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually” (v:27). There is no way that he is referring to the many denominations scattered throughout the world - as some try to teach (See also John 15:5-6). The “Body of Christ” refers to individual people who belong to Jesus (See Galatians 3:26-29).

Everybody in the *Body of Christ* is important regarding the proper functioning of the Body. Christ is the “Head,” (Colossians 1:18) sending out the directives. If you are a hand or a foot or an ear, etc., then you function as designed; and when each individual does his or her part, the body functions as intended.

The question for you and me is, “Am I doing my part, resulting in growth of the Body?” - (See Ephesians 4:11-16). It is my prayer that you are using your talent and ability (See Romans 12:4-8) for the honoring and glorifying of God (See Ephesians 3:21). It doesn’t matter who you are, YOU ARE SIGNIFICANT!!! Take care.

Chris' Corner...

Genesis 19:15-16

15 With the coming of dawn, the angels urged Lot, saying, "Hurry! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, or you will be swept away when the city is punished."

16 When he hesitated, the men grasped his hand and the hands of his wife and of his two daughters and led them safely out of the city, for the Lord was merciful to them.

God was about to destroy the city of Sodom and the angels were trying to get Lot and his family out safely. Even though destruction was apparent, Lot still hesitated. He hesitated because he was too involved and invested in the wicked city; but that wasn't always the case.

Earlier in Genesis we see Lot set up camp next to the city despite knowing how wicked it was. Later Lot was living inside the city. By the time the angels enter Sodom, Lot is found at the gateway of the city. That indicates that he was an official or had some kind of authority within Sodom. He went from living next to Sodom, to living inside, to being heavily involved with the city. So when it came time to flee it was difficult for him. Even his wife couldn't help but look back once she was out, and then she was turned into a pillar of salt.

We too often do the same with sin. We start off just hanging around sin or tempting situations. Eventually we are surrounded by sin and are so invested that it is hard to quit or leave. We must listen to the words in 2 Timothy 2:22 and flee from sin. Don't be like Lot and fall into the trap of sin, instead turn your back on sin and look to God.
