What Does the Bible Say?-About the Church-Part Three

The plea of the church of Christ is for a complete return to New Testament Christianity. Anything less or anything more God has declared to be unacceptable. The apostle Paul wrote: “I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed. For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ” (Galatians 1:6-10). The church must be as God would have her to be; not as man might desire!

The standard for determining what God desires is His Word. God has provided us with everything that we need for life and Godliness (See 2 Peter 1:3). He has given us His directives (See John 12:48). This is true about everything, including the features of Christ’s church. We (Individually and collectively) must **LISTEN** to Him (See Matthew 7:24-27).

The church of Christ is not one church among many as the devil would have you believe (See Ephesians 4:4-6). Jesus announced in Matthew 16:16-19 that He would build His church. Those who follow the New Testament teachings about salvation (See Acts 2:36-41), faithfulness (See Acts 2:42-47), service (See Romans 12:1-8), worship (See John 4:24), organization (See Ephesians 1:22-23, 1 Timothy 3:1-15, Philippians 1:1, etc.) and general Christian living (See James 1:27, Galatians 5:16-25, Romans 12:9-21, etc.) are His church. Those who disregard, for whatever reason, His teachings fall into the category as stated above in Galatians 1:6-10. There is a “Form” of doctrine that must be followed (See Romans 6:17).

My prayer is that the West Broward church of Christ will always strive to simply be HIS CHURCH! May we always be the

CHURCH OF CHRIST! Take care.

Luke 14:28-33

28 "Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won't you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it?"

29 For if you lay the foundation and are not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule you, **30** saying, 'This person began to build and wasn't able to finish.'

31 "Or suppose a king is about to go to war against another king. Won't he first sit down and consider whether he is able with ten thousand men to oppose the one coming against him with twenty thousand? **32** If he is not able, he will send a delegation while the other is still a long way off and will ask for terms of peace. **33** In the same way, those of you who do not give up everything you have cannot be my disciples.

As Christians we have to ask ourselves a question: "Is it worth it?" Jesus gives us an idea of how we should think before following Him, and what we must do to be His disciple. Just like a person building a house or a king going to war, we must consider the cost of being a Christian before we take action. This means we will have to give up something, if not everything, in order to be a true follower of Christ.

Unfortunately Satan and the world tell us that being a disciple of Christ is not worth sacrificing things we love here on earth. The thing we must focus on is what we will gain if we let go of the things of this world and live for God; and that is eternity in Heaven with Him! So have faith and realize the Heavenly pros outweigh the earthly cons.
